A NOTE FROM PASTOR STEPHANIE:

Christ is Risen! He is Risen indeed! Well, NOW WHAT? Christ is Risen, but how do I keep that joy and excitement alive within me, after all, I still have to go back to work and school, and pay the bills, and the surgery is still scheduled - life has not magically gotten any easier, So, NOW WHAT? Well, take this for what it's worth - but here are some suggestions to keep the resurrection faith growing within you.

Make church a priority - we miss you when you aren't here!

■ was working in your lives as you contemplated the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ for you. May the
■ joy and excitement of the Easter Season live within you so that you can "Tell the Peeps" the great good
■ news that Christ is Risen; He is Risen Indeed!
