Updated protocols for Covid-19.

Session has considered the May 13 guidance from the CDC on the wearing of masks by vaccinated individuals. The CDC does leave it up local jurisdictions, businesses, and venues to set their own rules for Covid protections. The following guidelines will be followed to ensure a safe experience for In-person Worship:

- For the safety of those who can't be vaccinated children and extremely vulnerable individuals- masks are required for people that are not vaccinated. For those individuals who are vaccinated, masks are optional.
- Seating has returned to normal (pre-Covid) capacity.
- There will be live song leaders and special music. Worshipers are welcome to sing along.
- For the children's message, kids are invited to come up front. There will be marks on the floor for them to sit on to maintain social distance.
- Offerings will again be collected by the ushers.
- There will be no nursery provided
- There will be fellowship time Sunday morning beginning at 9:30 A.M.

- LEADER: if they violate my statutes and do not keep my commandments,
- **PEOPLE:** then I will punish their transgression with the rod and their iniquity with scourges;
- LEADER: but I will not remove from him my steadfast love, or be false to my faithfulness.
- **PEOPLE:** I will not violate my covenant, or alter the word that went forth from my lips.
- LEADER: Once and for all I have sworn by my holiness; I will not lie to David.
- **PEOPLE:** His line shall continue forever, and his throne endure before me like the sun.
- LEADER: It shall be established forever like the moon, an enduring witness in the skies." *Selah* Mighty God, in fulfillment of the promise made to David you established a lasting covenant through Jesus, your beloved Son. You anointed him and raised him higher than all kings on earth. Remember your covenant, so that all who are marked with the cross of your Son may sing of your mercies forever; through your Son, Jesus Christ our Lord. **Amen**

* PRAYER OF CONFESSION

- LEADER: Do you not know that all of us who have been baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death? Our old selves were crucified with him, so that we might be slaves to sin no more. Trusting in God's grace, let us confess our sin.
- PEOPLE: Gracious God, our sins are too heavy to carry, too real to hide, and too deep to undo. Forgive what our lips tremble to name, what our hearts can no longer bear, and what has become for us a consuming fire of judgment. Set us free from a past that we cannot change; open to us a future in which we can be changed; and grant us grace to grow more and more in your likeness and image; through Jesus Christ, the light of the world. A MOMENT WITH CHILDREN

SCRIPTURE READING: 2 Samuel 7:1-14a

The words of scripture, inspired by God...

7 Now when the king was settled in his house, and the Lord had given him rest from all his enemies around him, 2 the king said to the prophet Nathan, "See now, I am living in a house of cedar, but the ark of God stays in a tent." 3 Nathan said to the king, "Go, do all that you have in mind; for the Lord is with you." 4 But that same night the word of the Lord came to Nathan: 5 Go and tell my servant David: Thus, says the Lord: Are you the one to build me a house to live in? 6 I have not lived in a house since the day I brought up the people of Israel from Egypt to this day, but I have been moving about in a tent and a tabernacle. 7 Wherever I have moved about among all the people of Israel, did I ever speak a word with any of the tribal leaders of Israel, whom I commanded to shepherd my people Israel, saying, "Why have you not built me a house of cedar?" 8 Now therefore thus you shall say to my servant David: Thus says the Lord of hosts: I took you from the pasture, from following the sheep to be prince over my people Israel; 9 and I have been with you wherever you went, and have cut off all your enemies from before you; and I will make for you a great name, like the name of the great ones of the earth. 10 And I will appoint a place for my people Israel and will plant them, so that they may live in their own place, and be disturbed no more; and evildoers shall afflict them no more, as formerly, 11 from the time that I appointed judges over my people Israel; and I will give you rest from all your enemies. Moreover, the Lord declares to you that the Lord will make you a house. 12 When your days are fulfilled and you lie down with your ancestors, I will raise up your offspring after you, who shall come forth from your body, and I will establish his kingdom. 13 He shall build a house for my name, and I will establish the throne of his kingdom forever, 14 I will be a father to him, and he shall be a son to me. When he commits iniquity, I will punish him with a rod such as mortals use, with blows inflicted by human beings.

These words are trustworthy and true. Thanks be to God.

PRAYER OF ILLUMINATION SERMON

AFFIRMATION OF FAITH

LEADER: In the 2nd century, the church sought to define their faith in the one God of Jacob and of Jesus, and so we proclaim in the Apostles' Creed:

- PEOPLE: "I believe in God the Father Almighty, maker of heaven and earth, and in Jesus Christ his only Son our Lord."
- LEADER: In the 4th century, the church was faced with a rift over the unity of the Trinity, and so we unite our voices and our faith with the words of the Nicene Creed:
- PEOPLE: "We believe in one God, the Father, the Almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all that is, seen and unseen."
- LEADER: In the heart of the 16th century reformation, the church needed to remind itself of what mattered most, and so we answer the first question of the Heidelberg Catechism: What is your only comfort in life and in death?
- PEOPLE: "That I am not my own, but belong— body and soul, in life and in death— to my faithful Savior, Jesus Christ."
- LEADER: In 1934, faced with the racist and anti-Semitic policies of Hitler's Germany, faithful German Christians resisted and responded, and so we have the words of the Barmen Declaration:
- PEOPLE: "We reject the false doctrine, as though the church were permitted to abandon the form of its message and order to its own pleasure or to changes in prevailing ideological and political convictions."
- LEADER: In the 1980s, the Dutch Reformed Church of South Africa saw generations of apartheid and oppression stifling the lives of black people, and so they penned the words of the Belhar Confession:
- PEOPLE: "We reject any doctrine which in such a situation sanctions in the name of the gospel or of the will of God the forced separation of people on the grounds of race and color and thereby in advance obstructs and weakens the ministry and experience of reconciliation in Christ."
- LEADER: Throughout Christian history, Christians have responded to the challenges of their faith in the world with creedal statements. Today, we recognize that tradition as we affirm our faith with the words of those who have struggled with their faith in the past. In 2021, the church faces as many obstacles as any generation before, and so we proclaim our commitments this day:
- PEOPLE: We are called to be a witness to the ongoing work of the Spirit: to stand against racism, injustice, and oppression in all forms; to love the strangers, to welcome the outsiders, and to work for the reign of Christ among us. Hallelujah! Amen!
