Come, LORD Jesus.


When the promise of your Scripture is hidden behind our anger...

Adult Bible Study



Bring your Bible or use one from the church.





Presbyterian Women begins the Advent Season with a potluck finger food buffet on Thursday, December 1st beginning at 6 p.m.


Coffee and punch will be served by the hostesses, Rita Thompson and Gwyn Calvetti.
